Undergraduate Research Conference Travel Award Submission Guidelines

Background

- The Office of Undergraduate Research (OUR) offers awards to Washington University undergraduates from all academic backgrounds.
- Awards to support travel to conferences and meetings will only be considered if the nominee is **PRESENTING** work at the meeting.
- Maximum award \$500.

Deadlines

Nominations for conference travel awards are accepted on a rolling basis. If it is necessary to receive funding before you travel, please submit your application at least four weeks in advance of the conference. Applications for funding for conference travel that has already taken place will NOT be considered.

Award Recipient Expectations

1. Awardees must receive explicit permission to present their findings from their faculty mentor.
2. Awardees must present their work at the undergraduate research symposium in the semester following receipt of the award. Details of this event will be covered in an Award Agreement.
3. For research activities involving human subjects, nominees must have received approval from the University's [Human Research Protection Office](#).
4. All awards are considered taxable income by federal, state, and local government.

Instructions for Students

Please submit the following:

1. [Mentor Recommendation Form](#) and Letter (submitted by your mentor)
2. Student Information Form
3. 1-2 page Research Summary (the Research Summary should include background, methods, implications, and importance to the field of study) and Conference Abstract
4. Itemized Budget and Budget Narrative justifying expenses, including dates of travel and efforts to save costs
